

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Chelsea Trestle Butterfly Extension Table

<u>Base Parts List</u>		<u>Hardware List</u>	
Leg Assembly	(2)	2" Lag Bolts	(2)
Stretcher	(1)	Black Lag Bolts	(8)
Table Top Assembly (<i>Figure 1</i>)	(1)	Flat Washers	(10)
		Levelers - <i>threaded into bottom of feet</i>	(4)

ATTENTION



Do Not Assemble with Power Tools

- 1) Place the Table Top Assembly (*Figure 1*) upside down on a soft, non-abrasive surface.

- 2) Make sure the slides are locked on both sides. See images below for slide locking mechanism positions.

- 3) Loosely attach the Stretcher to both Leg Assemblies using the holes in each leg with 2 - 2" Lag Bolts. Make sure the notch in the center of the Leg Assembly is facing the stretcher end. (*Figure 2*)

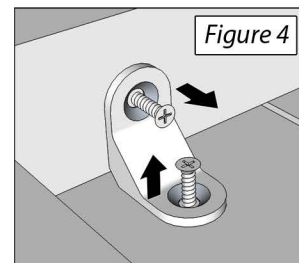
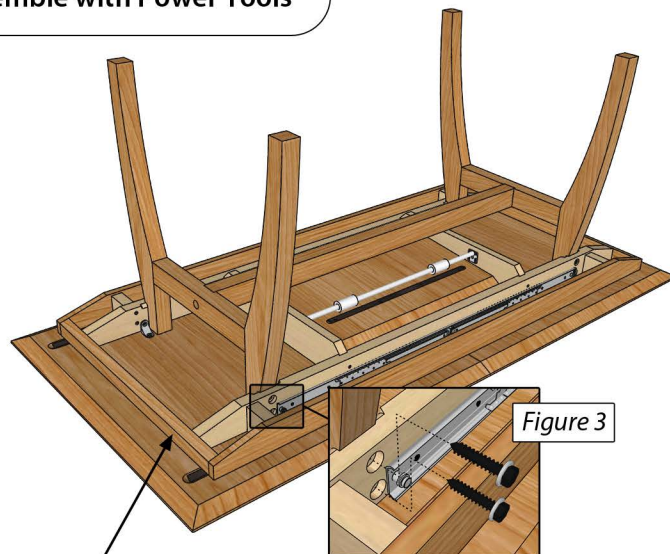

ATTENTION  Do Not Assemble with Power Tools

- 4) Set the base on the top, aligning the holes in the legs with the holes in the top assembly. (Figure 3)
- 5) Loosely attach the legs to the top assembly using the **8 - Black Lags**. (Figure 3)
- 6) Finish tightening all lags into place.
- 7) Carefully turn table upright.
- 8) Only when you're finished moving the table to where you want it, remove the 4 angle brackets that are screwed to the bottom of top and the inside of the stretchers. (Figure 4)



IMPORTANT: After removing shipping brackets, table must be moved/handled by lifting on base end bars located on either side of table. **Lifting the top alone can damage the slides.**

How to Open the Butterfly Leaf

- 1) Unlock both slides and pull one half of the table top out as far as it will go.
- 2) Open the leaf by pulling the top leaf half up and out. The leaf unfolds and places itself into position.



- 3) Push the table closed and lock the slides.
